Country Women's Association delivering emergency help

The Country Women's Association will distribute money raised from Woolworths National Backing Our Farmers Day to meet the immediate household needs of drought affected families in rural communities.

GRANTS AVAILABLE

- Up to \$2000 per household to help meet essential household expenses and other basic necessities such as food, clothing, fuel, emergency medical and dental costs, house rates, electricity and telephone expenses.
- Can include Woolworths Essentials cards, valued at \$250 each and redeemable for goods (excludes liquor or tobacco) in any Woolworths/Safeway, BIG W or Caltex/Woolworths

ELIGIBILITY

- People eligible to apply include farmers, farming dependent contractors, service providers and local rural businesses.
- If you are receiving a pension you may not be eligible (please enquire).
- Applicants must also show that their primary source of income has suffered as a direct result of the drought.
- Rural families in receipt of other drought assistance are not excluded from applying for emergency help through the Country Women's Association grants.
